



How to Help Reduce Auto Theft/Carjacking

Auto theft costs motorists millions of dollars each year. Be aware of your surroundings, especially who is around your vehicle, whether you are driving or leaving your vehicle in a parking lot. When parking your vehicle, park in a well-lit parking lot, close all windows, keep expensive goods out of sight and locked up, rent a vehicle, and call the police. Then if you are a victim, call 800.232.3333.

Other Safety Tips

- Keep your vehicle in good working condition.
- Have your vehicle identification number (VIN) chemically etched on the car window and main parts to help prevent your car from being stolen for parts.
- Alarms and interlocks to prevent other kinds of car theft can also discourage amateur carjackers.
- Tell people your route and estimated time of arrival at your beginning and ending stops.

Other Safety

- Keep your car locked
- Have your car etched on the inside of your car front window
- Alarms and locks can also dissuade would-be thieves
- Tell people about your beginning
